Sec. 7. EFFECTIVE DATE; ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW PRECINCTS.

This act is effective for the state primary and state general elections conducted in 2022 for terms of office beginning on the first Monday in January of 2023, and for all elections held thereafter. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, if a boundary adjustment contained in this act requires a county, city, or town to reestablish a precinct boundary to conform to the adjustment, the affected county, city, or town must reestablish the necessary precincts as soon as practicable, but in no case later than June 17, 2022.
