## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 85.053, subdivision 8, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. Military personnel; exemption free entrance. (a) A one-day permit, An annual permit under subdivision 4, shall 1 must be issued without a fee for a motor vehicle being used by a person who is serving in active military service in to a member of any branch or, unit, or reserve component of the United States armed forces and who is stationed outside Minnesota, during the period of active service and for 90 days immediately thereafter, or state National Guard or the member's dependents if the person presents the person's eurrent military orders a qualifying military identification or an annual pass for the United States military issued through the National Parks and Federal Lands Pass Program to the park attendant on duty or other designee of the commissioner.

- (b) For purposes of this section, "active service" has the meaning given under section 190.05, subdivision 5c, when performed outside Minnesota the commissioner shall establish what constitutes a qualifying military identification by written order published in the State Register. The written order is exempt from the rulemaking provisions of chapter 14, and section 14.386 does not apply.
- (c) A permit is not required for a motor vehicle being used by military personnel or their dependents who have in their possession the annual pass for United States military and their dependents issued by the federal government for access to federal recreation sites. For

(c) The commissioner may issue a daily vehicle permit free of charge to an individual

who qualifies under paragraph (a) and who does not own or operate a motor vehicle.
