1.2relating to human services; appropriating money to the commissioner of human

1.3services for grants for operating subsidies for rural mental health crisis facilities

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. APPROPRIATION; BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CRISIS FACILITY

1.7OPERATING SUBSIDY GRANTS.

1.8\$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated to the commissioner of human services

1.9for up to six grants for operating subsidies of up to \$500,000, each to be distributed monthly

1.10to a mental health program that operates in a facility developed as part of the behavioral

1.11health crisis facilities grant program under Minnesota Statutes, section 245G.011. Grant

1.12applicants shall submit a financial plan that includes the requested subsidy amount, proposed

1.13subsidy duration, documentation of the program's monthly operating costs and funding

1.14structure, and any other materials that the commissioner deems necessary to determine the

1.15subsidy amount. The commissioner shall approve the financial plan and the amount of the

1.16subsidy before funds may be distributed. Grants under this section may be made available

1.17for operating subsidies from July 1, 2022, until June 30, 2025. Grant recipients shall reconcile

1.18with the commissioner at the end of each fiscal year to ensure that the program's net

1.19operations are balanced before the final distribution is made. This is a onetime appropriation

1.20and is available until June 30, 2025.
