Appropriation. \$8,250,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 1.6 to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of 1.7 Richfield to deconstruct the existing nature center building at Wood Lake Nature Center 1.8 and renovate the site, and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a new nature 1.9 center building.
