BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **RICHFIELD; WOOD LAKE NATURE CENTER.**
- 1.6

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$8,250,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.7

to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the city of
- 1.8

Richfield to deconstruct the existing nature center building at Wood Lake Nature Center
- 1.9

and renovate the site, and to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip a new nature
- 1.10

center building. The project also includes landscaping around the new center and renovation
- 1.11

of the trails.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.14

the state in an amount up to \$8,250,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.15

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.16

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
