1.5 Section 1. **VIOLATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS DURING A PEACETIME**

1.6 **EMERGENCY.**

1.7 The Board of Cosmetologist Examiners may not impose additional penalties for a

1.8 violation of Executive Order 20-04, as extended, amended, and otherwise modified by

1.9 Executive Order 20-08, Executive Order 20-18, Executive Order 20-33, and any related

1.10 executive orders issued pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 12.21 or 12.31, to a business

1.11 licensed under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 155A.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
