1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. TAYLOR HAYDEN GUN VIOLENCE PREVENTION ACT.
1.6	This act may be cited as the "Taylor Hayden Gun Violence Prevention Act." To reduce
1.7	the number of injuries and deaths of innocent individuals in the community and to increase
1.8	community safety, the commissioner of health shall develop a competitive bidding process
1.9	to award grants to nonprofit organizations with expertise in gun violence prevention. A
1.10	nonprofit organization awarded a grant must use the money for gun violence prevention or
1.11	public awareness and education campaigns on gun violence prevention.
1.12	Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION.
1.13	\$200,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$200,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the
1.14	general fund to the commissioner of health to provide grants described in section 1.
