BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. CERTIFIED COMMUNITY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PILOT PROJECT.

Subdivision 1. Establishment. The commissioner of human services must establish a certified community behavioral health pilot project to transform community behavioral health systems and provide comprehensive coordinated behavioral health care that is family and culturally centered. The certified community behavioral health pilot project must assist Minnesota organizations that are certified community behavioral health clinics (CCBHCs) that provide comprehensive services including outreach, screening, assessment, treatment, care coordination, and recovery support that align with the most recently issued certified community behavioral health clinic certification criteria published by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration. The pilot project will run from October 1, 2024, until October 1, 2026.

Subd. 2. Eligibility. To be eligible to receive funding under this section, CCBHCs must be certified under Minnesota Statutes, section 245.735, subdivision 3, and must have completed the CCBHC behavioral health community certification and needs assessment. A CCBHC that receives funds under this section must submit documentation as required by the commissioner of human services.

Subd. 3. Requirements. (a) Funds received under this section must be used to provide services that are directly related to CCBHC certification criteria and must be used for services or practices that are evidence-based. An evidence-based service or practice refers to an

of human services for the certified community behavioral health pilot project. The general
