APPROPRIATION; METRO YOUTH DIVERSION CENTER. 1.5 (a) \$350,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$350,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated from 1.6 the workforce development fund to the commissioner of employment and economic 1.7 development for a grant to the Metro Youth Diversion Center (MYDC) to support its 1.8 Youth-Care Assessment and Readiness Education (Y-CARE) program.
