1.12	2, the remaining amount of the appropriation bond sale authorization in subdivision 2 may
1.13	be used to finance one or more of the following: land acquisition, design, engineering, and
1.14	construction of facilities and infrastructure necessary for Phase 3 of the Lewis and Clark
1.15	Regional Water System project. Phase 3 includes extension of the project from the
1.16	Lincoln-Pipestone Rural Water System connection near Adrian to Worthington, construction
