Appropriation; general obligation bond proceeds. \$5,600,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds account in the state transportation fund to the commissioner of transportation for one or more grants to the city of Byron, Olmsted County, or both for the county and city share of general obligation bond eligible portions of a project to conduct environmental analysis, predesign, and final design of a project to replace at-grade intersections and traffic signals with grade-separated interchanges along marked U.S. Highway 14, including but not limited to intersections with Olmsted County State-Aid Highway 3 and Olmsted County State-Aid Highway 5, in the city of Byron.
