1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.02, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.7	to read:
1.8	Subd. 6. Issuance of license or card. An applicant who submits a properly completed
1.9	application for a noncompliant driver's license, instruction permit, or identification card
1.10	must be provided with the license or card at the time of the application and at the location
1.11	of the application. The applicant must not be provided with a temporary license or card.
1.12	EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2022, and applies to applications
1.13	made on or after that date.
