1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 332B.02, subdivision 13, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 13. <b>Debt settlement services provider.</b> "Debt settlement services provider" means
1.7	any person offering or providing debt settlement services to a debtor domiciled in this state,
1.8	regardless of whether or not a fee is charged for the services and regardless of whether the
1.9	person maintains a physical presence in the state. The term includes any person to whom
1.10	debt settlement services are delegated. The term shall does not include:
1.11	(1) an exempt attorney at law and persons;
1.12	(2) a person listed in section 332A.02, subdivision 8, clauses (2) to (10);
1.13	(3) a registered accounting practitioner, registered accounting practitioner firm, certified
1.14	public accountant, or certified public accountant firm licensed under chapter 326A;
1.15	(4) an enrolled agent in good standing licensed by the United States Department of
1.16	Treasury under United States Code, title 31, section 330, or enrolled agent firm; or
1.17	(5) a debt management services provider.
