## Section 1. INTEREST IN LANDS EXTENDED. 1.5 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, Dakota County's reversionary interests in 1.6 1.7 lands deeded by Dakota County to the state of Minnesota, as contemplated by Laws 1975, chapter 382, are extended and remain permanently valid and operative. The land 1.8 is currently maintained and used for the purpose of a state zoological garden in Apple 1.9 Valley, Minnesota, and is described as Document No. 433980 and Document No. 439719, 1.10 recorded in the Dakota County Property Records Office, excluding lands subject to the 1.11 quit claim deeds recorded as Document No. 1246646 and Document No. 1330383. 1.12 EFFECTIVE DATE.
