1.5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.6	Section 1. MINNESOTA CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
1.7	Subdivision 1. <b>Appropriation.</b> \$5,407,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.8	fund to the commissioner of corrections to design, construct, and equip a security
1.9	perimeter fence at the Minnesota Correctional Facility-Shakopee. The fence may consist
1.10	of decorative iron pickets and masonry piers that will provide essential components of
1.11	effective and reliable escape detection and intrusion. This project may also include,
1.12	but is not limited to, installation of a fence protection system, additional lighting and
