1.2relating to transportation; requiring a safety improvement study for the interchange

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. INTERSTATE 94/494/694 INTERCHANGE SAFETY IMPROVEMENT

1.6AND CONGESTION RELIEF STUDY.

1.7The commissioner of transportation must conduct a safety improvement and congestion

1.8relief study for the interchange of signed Interstate Highways 94, 494, and 694 in the cities

1.9of Oakdale and Woodbury. At a minimum, the study must (1) provide specific

1.10recommendations to improve the safety of the interchange and reduce congestion at the

1.11interchange and on associated arterial roads, and (2) include cost estimates for each

1.12recommended improvement. The commissioner must report the findings and

1.13recommendations of the study to the legislative committees having jurisdiction over

1.14transportation policy and finance within 180 days after the effective date of this section.

1.15EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
