1.2relating to human services; appropriating money for housing needs.

1.3BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS.

1.5(a) \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated

1.6from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the long-term homeless

1.7supportive services fund under Minnesota Statutes, section 256K.26.

1.8(b) \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$1,500,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated

1.9from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for a housing with supports

1.10for adults with serious mental illness grant program, which is a grant program for housing

1.11developers, county mental health authorities, and tribes to increase supportive housing

1.12options.

1.13(c) \$500,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from

1.14the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the transitional housing program

1.15under Minnesota Statutes, section 256E.33.

1.16(d) \$250,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$250,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated from

1.17the general fund to the commissioner of human services for the emergency services program,
