(a) When dispensing prescription opioids, a 1.6 dispenser must provide to a patient, the patient's agent, or the patient's caregiver, clear and 1.7 conspicuous written information, in plan language, about: 1.8 1.9 (1) the addictive nature of opioids and the risks of opioid abuse; and (2) safe disposal of unused prescription opioids. Board of Pharmacy development of materials.
