1.3BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.4Section 1. **SANNEH FOUNDATION GRANT.**

1.5Subdivision 1. **Department of Education.** The sums indicated in this section are

1.6appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Education for the fiscal years

1.7designated.

1.8Subd. 2. **Sanneh Foundation.** For grants to the Sanneh Foundation for purposes of

1.9subdivision 3:

1.11	\$	<u>2,000,000</u>	<u>.....</u>	<u>2023</u>

1.12Subd. 3. **Grant uses.** The grants to the Sanneh Foundation must be directed toward

1.13programs for low-performing and chronically absent students with a focus on low-income

1.14students and students of color. The goals of the grants include decreasing absenteeism,

1.15encouraging school engagement, improving grades, and improving graduation rates. The

1.16grants may be used to:

1.17(1) provide all-day, in-school academic and behavioral interventions and social and

1.18emotional learning throughout the school year;

1.19(2) provide year-round, out-of-school behavioral, social, and emotional learning

1.20interventions and enrichment activities;

2.1 (3) enhance career exploration opportunities, including exposure to businesses and  
2.2 business activities; and

2.3 (4) develop pathways in cooperation with business higher education partners for  
2.4 participants to pursue careers in education and youth development.
