1.2 relating to higher education; providing for the use of student data; proposing

1.3 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 136A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **[136A.051] STUDENT RECORDS AND DATA.**

1.6 When a nonpublic institution of higher education provides the Office of Higher

1.7 Education student data or records pursuant to section 136A.05, subdivision 1; 136A.121,

1.8 subdivision 18; or 136A.1701, subdivision 11, the institution of higher education is not

1.9 liable for a breach of confidentiality, disclosure, use, retention, or destruction of the

1.10 student data or records, if the breach, disclosure, use, retention, or destruction results from

1.11 actions or omissions of:

1.12 (1) the Office of Higher Education; or

1.13 (2) persons provided access to the data or records by the Office of Higher Education.
