1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. APPROPRIATION; CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT.

1.6\$500,000 in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7of human rights to study and make recommendations for an amendment to the Minnesota

1.8Constitution affirming the enforcement of human rights. The commissioner shall conduct

1.9surveys and hold statewide community meetings for the purpose of educating communities

1.10on the constitutional amendment and gauging community support for a constitutional

1.11amendment. This is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2024.
