No Class I or Class II railroad shall allow the operation of a railroad train or locomotive in this state, used in connection with the movement of freight or passengers, without a crew composed of a minimum of two individuals, except hostling and helper operations, remote control locomotives in yards, and as otherwise provided by Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 218, subpart B. A railroad that violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, in addition to any other sanctions authorized in law, shall be ordered to pay a fine of at least \$250 for a first-time violation of this section, and \$1,000 for a second or subsequent violation.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2015, and applies to crimes committed on or after that date.
