	Subdivision 1. Definition. For purposes of this section, "warrior-style training" means
	training for peace officers that teaches that self-preservation of an officer is an officer's
]	highest priority or that trains peace officers to approach each interaction with a citizen as a
1	threat, or potential threat, to an officer's safety.
	Subd. 2. No continuing education credits or tuition reimbursement. (a) The board
	may not certify a continuing education course that includes warrior-style training.
	(b) The board may not grant continuing education credit to a peace officer for a course
1	that includes warrior-style training.
	(c) The board may not reimburse a law enforcement agency or a peace officer for a
	course that includes warrior-style training.
	Subd. 3. Training prohibited. A law enforcement agency may not provide warrior-style

1.17 training, directly or through a third party, to a peace officer.
