2.6 (10) remove pledged goods from the pawnshop premises or other storage place

2.8 the expiration of the redemption period pursuant to section 325J.06. However, (i) a
2.9 pawnbroker is permitted to return pledged goods to the borrower at any time during the
2.10 redemption period, (ii) a pawnbroker is permitted to sell the pledged goods or remove
2.11 the pledged goods from the pawnshop premises or other storage at any time after the
2.12 expiration of the redemption period set forth in section 325J.06, and (iii) a pawnbroker
2.13 who purchases goods not involving a pawn transaction is permitted to sell or remove the
2.14 purchased goods from the pawnshop premises or other storage 31 days or later from the
2.15 purchase transaction date.

2.18 With the exception of section 325J.08, clauses (7) and (10), nothing in this chapter
2.19 preempts or supersedes any ordinance adopted by a municipality that provides for more
2.20 restrictive regulation of pawnbrokers or pawn transactions.
