BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. PLAN TO ADDRESS BARRIERS TO EMPLOYMENT.

The commissioner of employment and economic development must consult with the commissioners of health and human services and stakeholders in order to identify the barriers that people with mental illness face in obtaining employment and all current programs that assist people with mental illness in obtaining employment. Stakeholders shall include people with mental illness and their families, mental health advocates, mental health providers, and employers. The commissioner of employment and economic development shall submit a detailed plan to the legislative committees with jurisdiction over employment and human services before February 1, 2020, identifying the barriers to employment and making recommendations on how to best improve the employment rate among people with mental illness.
