1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 97B.645, subdivision 9, is amended to read:
 Subd. 9. Open season; moratorium. Beginning June 30, 2013, there shall be
 no open season for wolves until after the wolf is delisted under the federal Endangered
 Species Act of 1973 for a five-year period. After that time, the commissioner may
 prescribe open seasons and restrictions for taking wolves but <u>only if population</u>
- 1.10 management is deemed necessary and other means for controlling the wolf population are
- 1.11 <u>explored. The commissioner must provide opportunity for public comment.</u>
