BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 169.475, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
- Subd. 2. **Prohibition on use; penalty.** (a) No A person may operate operating a motor vehicle while is prohibited from using a wireless communications device to compose, read, or send an electronic message, when the vehicle is in motion or a part of traffic.
- (b) A person who violates paragraph (a) is subject to the following fines:
- 1.11 (1) for a first offense, a fine of \$175, plus the amount specified in the uniform fine
 1.12 schedule established by the Judicial Council;
 - (2) for a second or subsequent time must pay offense, a fine of \$225 \$350, plus the amount specified in the uniform fine schedule established by the Judicial Council-; and
- 1.15 (3) for a third or subsequent offense, a fine of \$700, plus the amount specified in the uniform fine schedule established by the Judicial Council.
- (c) If an individual causes a collision that results in substantial bodily harm, as defined in section 609.02, subdivision 7a, or the death of another, as a result of violating paragraph (a), the individual is subject to the fine authorized in paragraph (b) multiplied by two.
