- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to human rights; changing statutory provisions to conform with Minnesota
- 1.3 Human Rights Act; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 256C.02.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 256C.02, is amended to read:
- 1.6 **256C.02 PUBLIC ACCOMMODATIONS.**
- 1.7 People who are blind or people with a visual or physical disability have the same right
- 1.8 as the able-bodied to the full and free use of the streets, highways, sidewalks, walkways,
- 1.9 public buildings, public facilities, and other public places; and are entitled to full and equal
- 1.10 accommodations, advantages, facilities, and privileges of all common carriers, airplanes,
- 1.11 motor vehicles, railroad trains, motor buses, boats, or any other public conveyances or
- 1.12 modes of transportation, hotels, lodging places, places of public accommodation, amusement,
- 1.13 or resort, and other places to which the general public is invited, subject only to the conditions
- 1.14 and limitations established by law and applicable alike to all persons.
- 1.15 Every person who is totally or partially blind, or person who is deaf, or person with a
- 1.16 physical disability, or any person training ~~a dog~~ an animal to be a service ~~dog~~ animal shall
- 1.17 have the right to be accompanied by a service ~~dog~~ animal in any of the places listed in
- 1.18 section 363A.19. The person shall be liable for any damage done to the premises or facilities
- 1.19 by ~~such dog~~ the service animal. ~~The service dog must be capable of being properly identified~~
- 1.20 ~~as from a recognized school for seeing eye, hearing ear, service, or guide dogs.~~
