1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to public safety; appropriating money for a domestic abuse prevention

1.3 program for veterans and their families.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **DOMESTIC ABUSE PREVENTION GRANTS.**

1.6 \$398,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$398,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the

1.7 general fund to the commissioner of public safety for a grant to a domestic abuse prevention

1.8 program that provides interdisciplinary, trauma-informed treatment and evidence-informed

1.9 intervention for veterans and current or former service members and their whole families

1.10 affected by domestic violence. The grantee must offer a combination of services for

1.11 perpetrators of domestic violence and their families, including individual and group therapy,

1.12 evaluation and research of programming, and short- and long-term case management services

1.13 to ensure stabilization and increase in their overall mental health functioning and well-being.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
