(a) The board shall identify 18 prescribers whose authority to prescribe controlled substances is restricted. The board shall 19 make information about any current restriction on a prescriber's prescribing authority readily 1.10 available to licensed dispensers, either by including the information in the prescription 1.11 monitoring program, or by otherwise providing periodic updates to licensees. 1.12 (b) On a quarterly basis, the board shall consult with the United States Drug Enforcement 1.13 Administration; the National Practitioner Data Bank, or any successor database; and each 1.14 Minnesota health-related licensing board that licenses prescribers to identify prescribers 1.15

whose authority to prescribe controlled substances is restricted.
