1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 152.126, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7to read:

1.8Subd. 5a. **Prescribing restrictions to be documented.** (a) The board shall identify

1.9prescribers whose authority to prescribe controlled substances is restricted. The board shall

1.10make information about any current restriction on a prescriber's prescribing authority readily

1.11available to licensed dispensers, either by including the information in the prescription

1.12monitoring program, or by otherwise providing periodic updates to licensees.

1.13(b) On a quarterly basis, the board shall consult with the United States Drug Enforcement

1.14Administration; the National Practitioner Data Bank, or any successor database; and each

1.15Minnesota health-related licensing board that licenses prescribers to identify prescribers

1.16whose authority to prescribe controlled substances is restricted.
