BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.4 Section 1. SIBLEY COUNTY; CSAH 6. 1.5 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$18,664,500 is appropriated from the bond proceeds 1.6 fund to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to Sibley County to predesign, design, 1.7 engineer, acquire right-of-way for, and construct improvements to Sibley County State-Aid 1.8 Highway 6, known as Scenic Byway 6, to raise the road to meet the 50-year flood level, 1.9 provide for a walking and bicycling lane, and reconstruct the intersection of Scenic Byway 1.10 6 and Sibley County State-Aid Highway 5. This appropriation does not require a nonstate 1.11 contribution. 1.12 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond 1.13 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of 1.14 the state in an amount up to \$18,664,500 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect 1.15 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota 1.16 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. 1.17
