Notwithstanding Minnesota Rules, 1.8 part 9503.0145, subpart 8, and Minnesota Rules, part 9502.0445, subpart 1, a child care 1.9 program may provide drinking water for children in individual covered water bottles, labeled 1.10 with the child's name. Water bottles provided by the child care program must be washed, 1.11 rinsed, and sanitized daily after use and stored clean and dry in a manner that protects them 1.12 from contamination. 1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment. 1.14
