1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 256B.0752, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 2. **Evaluation reports.** The commissioners ~~shall~~ must provide to the legislature

1.8 comprehensive evaluations of the health care home model three years and five years after

1.9 implementation. The report must include:

1.10 (1) the number of state health care program enrollees in health care homes and the

1.11 number and characteristics of enrollees with complex or chronic conditions, identified by

1.12 income, disability, race, ethnicity, and language;

1.13 (2) the number and geographic distribution of health care home providers;

1.14 (3) the performance and quality of care of health care homes;

1.15 (4) measures of preventive care;

1.16 (5) health care home payment arrangements, and costs related to implementation and

1.17 payment of care coordination fees;

1.18 (6) the estimated impact of health care homes on health disparities; and

1.19 (7) estimated savings from implementation of the health care home model for the

1.20 fee-for-service, managed care, and county-based purchasing sectors.
