1.1 A bill for an act

relating to capital investment; appropriating money for implementation of quiet zones in New Brighton; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. NEW BRIGHTON; QUIET ZONES.

Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,029,100 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of New Brighton to predesign, design, engineer, construct, and equip new passive and active rail grade crossing warning safety devices necessary to establish three quiet zone areas at five grade crossings of railroad tracks and city streets. Of this amount, \$1,769,100 is for quiet zone five, which consists of at-grade crossings on 1st Street NW, 1st Street SW, and 5th Avenue SW; \$770,000 is for quiet zone six, which has one at-grade crossing at County Road D; and \$490,000 is for quiet zone seven, which has one at-grade crossing at Old Highway 8. This appropriation does not require a nonstate contribution.

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$3,029,100 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
