1.2 relating to health; modifying licensure requirements; amending Minnesota Statutes

1.3 2018, section 150A.06, subdivision 6.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 150A.06, subdivision 6, is amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 6. **Display of name and certificates.** (a) ~~The initial license and subsequent renewal~~

1.7 ~~certificate of every dentist, dental therapist, dental hygienist, or dental assistant shall~~ must

1.8 ~~be conspicuously displayed in plain sight of patients in every office in which that person~~

1.9 ~~practices, in plain sight of patients. When available from the board, the board shall allow~~

1.10 ~~the display of a wallet-sized initial license and wallet-sized subsequent renewal certificate~~

1.11 ~~only at nonprimary practice locations instead of displaying an original-sized initial license~~

1.12 ~~and subsequent renewal certificate. Duplicate renewal certificates may be obtained from~~

1.13 the board.

1.14 (b) Near or on the entrance door to every office where dentistry is practiced, the name

1.15 of each dentist practicing there, as inscribed on the current license certificate, ~~shall~~ must be

1.16 displayed in plain sight.

1.17 (c) The board must allow the display of a mini-license for guest license holders

1.18 performing volunteer dental services. There is no fee for the mini-license for guest volunteers.
