1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 256I.05, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 1s. Supplemental rate; Douglas County. Notwithstanding the provisions in this

1.9 section, beginning July 1, 2020, a county agency shall negotiate a supplemental rate for up

1.10 to 20 beds in addition to the rate specified in subdivision 1, not to exceed the maximum rate

1.11 allowed under subdivision 1a, including any legislatively authorized inflationary adjustments,

1.12 for a housing support provider located in Douglas County that operates two facilities and

1.13 provides room and board and supplementary services to adult males recovering from

1.14 substance use disorder, mental illness, or housing instability.

1.15 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective July 1, 2020.
