1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to insurance; health; prohibiting a health plan company from including  
1.3 certain provisions in contracts; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,  
1.4 chapter 62Q.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. [62Q.741] PROHIBITION ON PROVIDER EXCLUSION IN  
1.7 CONTRACTS.

1.8 A health plan company shall not include as part of its contract with a health care provider  
1.9 a requirement excluding any other health care provider from contracting with the health  
1.10 plan company or from contracting to be part of the network of providers for a health plan.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2020, and applies to contracts  
1.12 executed on or after that date.
