- (c) The institution must remove from a student's academic transcript the notation placed on a transcript pursuant to paragraph (a):
 - (1) if the notation was due to the student's suspension and the student completed the term and any conditions of the suspension and has been determined by the institution to be in good standing according to the institution's code, rules, or set of standards governing the determination; or
- (2) if ten years have passed since the transcript notation. 2.18
