OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to liquor; allowing some transfers of wine between commonly owned  
1.3 liquor stores; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 340A.412, by adding a  
1.4 subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 340A.412, is amended by adding a subdivision  
1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 12a. Wine transfers. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 12, the holder  
1.9 of a retail intoxicating liquor license may transfer wine from one licensed premises to another  
1.10 provided that:

1.11 (1) the license for the transferring and receiving premises are held by the same licensee;  
1.12 and

1.13 (2) only one transfer is made from a licensed premises in a three-month period.

1.14 EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
