Whoever violates subdivision 2, clause (2), is guilty of a felony and may be sentenced 1.9 as follows: 1.10 (1) to imprisonment for not more than ten years or to payment of a fine of not more than 1.11 \$20,000, or both, if the call triggers an emergency response and, as a result of the response, 1.12 someone suffers great bodily harm or death-; or 1.13 (2) to imprisonment of not more than three years or to payment of a fine of not more 1 14 than \$10,000, or both, if the call triggers an emergency response and as a result of the 1.15 response, someone suffers substantial bodily harm. 1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2020, and applies to crimes 1.17
