Building; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds. 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1 5 Section 1. AGRICULTURE AND HEALTH LAB. 1.6 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** (a) \$20,499,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds 17 fund to the commissioner of administration to design and construct the renovation of and 1.8 improvements to the Minnesota Departments of Agriculture and Health Laboratory Building 1.9 that are needed to correct safety and energy and operational efficiency problems. The project 1.10 includes but is not limited to construction of a biosafety level 3 laboratory space, installing 1.11 a centralized, building-wide uninterruptable power supply, and replacement and updating 1.12 of HVAC systems. 1.13 (b) \$799,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of administration 1.14 for costs of moving scientific equipment and subsequent calibrations and verifications of 1.15 the equipment's performance. 1.16 Subd. 2. Bond sale.
