1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 169.442, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Signals required.** (a) A type A, B, C, or D school bus must be equipped

1.8 with at least one stop-signal arm, prewarning flashing amber signals, and flashing red signals.

1.9 (b) Notwithstanding section 169.80, subdivision 2, a new type A, B, C, or D school bus

1.10 purchased on or after August 1, 2022, must be equipped with a stop-signal arm extension

1.11 that extends a minimum of six feet from the bus.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2022.
