 1.3 unit; amending Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 179A.03, subdivision 18.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2012, section 179A.03, subdivision 18, is amended to
 1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 18. **Teacher.** "Teacher" means any public employee other than a
 1.8 superintendent or assistant superintendent, principal, assistant principal, or a supervisory
 1.9 or confidential employee, employed by a school district:

1.10 (1) in a position for which the person must be licensed by the Board of Teaching or
 1.11 the commissioner of education; or

1.12 (2) in a position as a physical therapist ~~or an~~ occupational therapist, art therapist,
 1.13 music therapist, or audiologist.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective July 1, 2014.
