1.6	Section 1. MINNESOTA VETERANS HOME; MINNEAPOLIS.
1.7	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$3,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
1.8	to the commissioner of administration for predesign and design, including environmental
1.9	and hazardous materials abatement assessments, for the remodeling and rehabilitation of
1.10	historic building 6 at the Minnesota Veterans Home in Minneapolis. The unspent portion
1.11	of this appropriation after building predesign and design has been substantially completed,
1.12	upon written notice to the commissioner of management and budget, is available for
1.13	construction, furnishing, and equipping accommodations for up to 45 additional nursing
1.14	home resident beds. Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642, applies from the date of the
1.15	original appropriation to the unspent amount transferred.
