1.8	Subdivision 1. Trunk Highway 65 interchange; appropriation. (a) \$30,000,000 in
1.9	fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of transportation
1.10	for one or more grants to the city of Blaine for a local road interchange at 117th Avenue
1.11	Northeast, Cloud Drive Northeast, and marked Trunk Highway 65, including any associated:
1.12	(1) local road improvements; (2) frontage roads; (3) acquisition of rights-of-way; (4) utility
1.13	infrastructure improvements; and (5) construction administration and inspection. This is a
