1.7	Subd. 9. Sales or lease required. No licensed manufacturer may refuse to sell or lease
1.8	gambling equipment to a licensed distributor unless:
1.9	(1) a specific type of gambling equipment sold on an exclusive basis is at issue;
1.10	(2) the manufacturer does not sell or lease gambling equipment to any distributor in
1.11	Minnesota;
1.12	(3) a Minnesota statute or rule prohibits the sale; or
1.13	(4) the distributor is delinquent on any payment owed to the manufacturer.
1.14	This subdivision does not apply to application software and those computer programs
1.15	used by a licensed manufacturer in the production, play, and reporting of board-approved
1.16	electronic pull-tab games or electronic bingo games.
