2.2	(1) provide the data described in paragraph (a) on an annual basis as part of the report
2.3	required under Minnesota Statutes, section 257.0725;
2.4	(2) facilitate children's continued participation in early care and education programs
2.5	after reunification, adoption, or transfer of permanent legal and physical custody; and
2.6	(3) regularly report measures of early childhood well-being for children who have
2.7	experienced foster care. "Measures of early childhood well-being" include developmental
2.8	screening, school readiness assessments, well-child medical visits, and other indicators as
2.9	determined by the commissioner, in consultation with the commissioners of health, education,
2.10	and management and budget, county social service and public health agencies, and school
2.11	districts.
2.12	(c) The report shall include an implementation plan to increase the rates of participation
2.13	among children and their foster families in early care and education programs, including
2.14	processes for referrals and follow-up. The plan shall be developed in collaboration with
2.15	affected communities and families, incorporating their experiences and feedback. County
2.16	social service and public health agencies and school districts shall also collaborate on the
2.17	plan's development and implementation strategy.
2.18	(d) The report shall identify barriers to be addressed to ensure that early care and
2.19	education programs are responsive to the cultural, logistical, and racial equity concerns and
2.20	needs of children's foster families and families of origin, and the report shall identify methods
2.21	to ensure the experiences and feedback from children's foster families and families of origin
2.22	are included in the ongoing implementation of early care and education programs.

2.24	an interim report, and by June 30, 2022, the commissioner shall submit the final report
