1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to education; appropriating money for a grant to expand executive function
1.3 curriculum; requiring a report.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. EXECUTIVE FUNCTION CURRICULUM GRANT; APPROPRIATION.

1.6 Subdivision 1. Department of Education. The sum in this section is appropriated from
1.7 the general fund to the commissioner of education for the fiscal year designated.

1.8 Subd. 2. Executive function across generations curriculum grant. (a) For a grant to
1.9 the family partnership for an executive function curriculum pilot program:

1.10 \$ 500,000 2024

1.11 (b) The family partnership must establish ten sites across Minnesota to provide executive
1.12 function across generations curriculum. The sites must be spread across the state and include
1.13 rural, suburban, and urban early education and care providers, organizations providing home
1.14 visiting services, or parenting groups in high-risk communities. The family partnership must
1.15 report to the legislature by December 15, 2024, and December 15, 2025, on the progress
1.16 made to expand the executive function curriculum across Minnesota.

1.17 (c) This appropriation is available until June 30, 2025.
