1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **ATTORNEY GENERAL; CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT**

1.6 **APPROPRIATIONS.**

1.7 (a) \$269,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the attorney

1.8 general for enhanced criminal enforcement and related initiatives. This is a onetime

1.9 appropriation.

1.10 (b) \$2,021,000 in fiscal year 2024 and \$2,021,000 in fiscal year 2025 are appropriated

1.11 from the general fund to the attorney general for enhanced criminal enforcement and related

1.12 initiatives.

1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
